

## Chase the Ace Contest Rules

- 1) The game will commence on Sunday September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2017 and be 52 weeks in duration, or until the Ace of Spades is drawn, whichever comes first.
- 2) Ticket prices are;
  - 1 for \$2.00
  - 3 for \$5.00
  - 7 for \$10.00
  - 15 for \$20.00
- 3) Tickets will be sold at the Five Bridges Bar & Grill, 121 Pine Glen Rd. Riverview Wed & Fri between 5:30pm – 7:30pm, and at the Riverview Lions Club from 6:00pm to 8:00pm on Sundays; or other hours as required and approved by the Province of New Brunswick.
- 4) Ticket sales are prohibited to anyone under the age of 19.
- 5) The draw will take place at the Riverview Lions Club (701 Coverdale Rd., Riverview) at 8:15pm on Sundays commencing September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2017. In the event of a cancellation due to events beyond our control (i.e. weather) the proceeds will be added to the jackpot and a draw will be made the following week at the regularly scheduled date/time. Should the draw reach the point where we reach maximum capacity for the facility the draw will be relocated to an acceptable facility (to be announced in advance).
- 6) The participant is responsible for inspecting their tickets at the time of purchase for accuracy and legibility of numbers.
- 7) Participants may allow people to purchase tickets on their behalf, but please note that all prize money will be awarded to the “ticket holder”.
- 8) Participants do not need to be present to win, however they must be present to draw for the Ace of Spades; or in their absence a delegate will be appointed by the Draw Supervisor.
- 9) Distribution of the weekly ticket sales will be as follows:
  - a. 20% of the weekly ticket sales and a chance to draw the Ace of Spades from a deck of cards will be awarded to the winning ticket holder.
  - b. 30% of the weekly ticket sales will go into the Chase the Ace jackpot.
  - c. 50% of the weekly sales will be split equally between The Riverview Lions Club and the Frank L. Bowser Playground Project.
- 10) The Chase the Ace jackpot will begin at a guaranteed \$5,000 and remain as such until the cumulative amount from 9b (above) exceeds \$5,000. From that point onward, the jackpot will increase as described in 9b (above).
- 11) The Draw Supervisor must be wearing a short-sleeved shirt or have their sleeves rolled up.
- 12) A video of the draw will be digitally recorded and kept on file for the duration of the licence, or one week after a winner has been declared, whichever is longer.
- 13) Prior to the draw, the Draw Supervisor will announce the 20% consolation prize; the 30% added to the Chase the Ace jackpot, and the total jackpot for the evening’s draw.

- 14) The Draw Supervisor will draw one ticket from the barrel. The ticket number and colour will be read aloud a minimum of 3 times, posted on the [www.riverviewcta.com](http://www.riverviewcta.com) site and made available via other media sources.
- 15) The person holding the winning ticket (both colour and number must be a match) will win 20% of the week's ticket sales and have a chance to draw for the Ace of Spades to win the Chase the Ace jackpot. The winning ticket holder may designate someone else to select a card on their behalf; however, the designated person is not entitled to any of the winnings. All consolation prizes must be claimed within 30 days of the draw.
- 16) The winning ticket holder must present themselves to the Draw Supervisor within 15 minutes of the draw. Failure to do so will result in a designated person selecting a card from the deck on the winner's behalf. The designated person selecting the card is not entitled to any of the winnings.
- 17) For each draw, the same deck of cards will be used. The deck of cards will be displayed in such a manner as to confirm that the Ace of Spades is in the deck. It will then be shuffled and placed on a table. The Draw Supervisor will randomly spread the cards out on the table. The winning ticket holder (or designee) will place one finger on one card and keep it in place until instructed to remove it. The Draw Supervisor will remove the cards around the selection such that there will be no controversy as to which card was selected. In the event that the participant's finger could be deemed to be selecting more than one card the Draw Supervisor will ask them to confirm their selection and all other cards will be moved away. The Draw Supervisor will then flip the selected card over for all to see.
- 18) If the Ace of Spades is selected the game is over. The winning ticket holder will receive the Chase the Ace jackpot (which includes 30% of the week's ticket sales). The winning ticket holder will have 30 days from the time of the draw to claim their prize. To claim the prize the physical ticket must be presented and validated to be an original. If the prize is not claimed within 30 days the Chase the Ace Jackpot will be deemed to be a donation to be split equally between the Riverview Lions Club and the Frank L. Bowser Playground Project.
- 19) If the card selected is not the Ace of Spades it will be cut in half and kept for audit purposes for the duration of the licence, or one week after a winner has been declared, whichever is longer. The deck of cards will be locked in a secure place within the Riverview Lions Club and the game continues the following week.
- 20) The game continues until the Ace of Spades is drawn or the licence expires.
- 21) In the event that the licence will expire, or there is reason to end the contest prematurely, and an Ace of Spades has not yet been drawn, the following final draw procedures will apply:
  - a. The regular weekly draw will occur as per the above noted rules with the winning ticket holder claiming 20% of the week's sales and a chance to draw for the Ace of Spades.
  - b. If the Ace of Spades is not selected another ticket will be drawn and the new winning ticket holder (or designee) will select a card. This will continue until the Ace of Spades is selected and we have a winner. The winner will receive only the Chase the Ace jackpot.

- 22) A record of the draw date, draw location, Draw Supervisor name, winning ticket number, winning ticket holder's name, name of the person selecting the card, the card selected, and all monetary amounts for the week's draw will be recorded and kept on file for the duration of the licence.
- 23) For promotional purposes any Chase the Ace prize winner will automatically be deemed to grant the hosting groups the right to publish through all types of media, including internet, their full name, hometown and photographs without any claim. Any winner who is paid a prize also gives the above noted organizers the right to publish any additional information that they voluntarily provide.
